

The first hurdle was to come up with a template, a format, into which the data could be entered to extract useful information. Luckily, we have a parishioner, Robin Shields, who did this kind of thing for a living and was generous enough to create such a template. Now that that's in place, the committee members have been taking turns entering the data from the more than 500 surveys we received. Just over half have been processed, nearly all from the church-going members of the parish. I hope we'll be able to make a preliminary report in the not-toodistant future as clearer patterns emerge. 
