

## **DIVINE MERCY**

In the 1930's a special devotion began to spread through the Church. A young polish nun, now Saint Faustina Kowalska, was visited by Jesus, in a private

revelation, who instructed her to spread the message of his "Divine Mercy."

The message is simple: God loves us no matter how great our sins are. This doesn't mean that he overlooks our sin, but he wants us to realize that his mercy is infinitely greater than us! Jesus instructed that an image be commissioned with Himself at the center, and two rays emanating from his Sacred Heart, one white ray (symbolizing the cleansing power of baptism) and one red ray (symbolizing the blood Jesus shed on the cross to save us from our sins). At the bottom of this image, Faustina tells us that Jesus instructed that the words, *"Jesus, I Trust in You"* be prominently displayed. Trust in Jesus' mercy and love is at the heart of this beautiful devotion.

Furthermore, Jesus instructed that the Second Sunday of Easter be celebrated as "Divine Mercy Sunday." In our own century, Pope John Paul II extended the celebration of this special feast to the Universal Church. Observing Divine Mercy Sunday means going to Mass and Confession on that day and praying the Chaplet of Divine Mercy, a simple yet powerful prayer, prayed with ordinary rosary beads.

We will celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday next Sunday, April 12th at St. Romuald Chapel.

The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed at 1:00PM. The Chaplet of Divine Mercy will be prayed at 2:50PM (materials will be provided). The afternoon will conclude with a special Celebration of Mass at 3:00PM, the hour of mercy, celebrated by Fr. Nicholas P. Smith, Pastor Emeritus.

Confessions will not be offered. Please note that if you went to confession during Lent, within 20 days prior to Divine Mercy Sunday or within 20 days following Mercy Sunday, you are covered under the conditions for a plenary indulgence.
