

## From the Pastor,

As you heard last weekend, we're gearing up for the next phase of our diocesan campaign. The parish will receive 40% of the goal, which is \$626,135. Something over \$200,000 has been pledged already from around half a dozen gifts.

In the next phase, which we're about to enter, we need volunteers to help with the five receptions for parishioners and in making telephone calls to the invitees. These telephone volunteers WILL NOT BE ASKING ANYONE FOR MONEY. They will simply ask if the persons received the letter of invitation and express the hope that they will be able to attend one or another of the receptions scheduled in the parish hall. After the reception, they will call again to thank those who came and to encourage them to return the pledge card if they have not already done so. Our valiant and long-time parishioner Dana Hawkins has agreed to coordinate the telephone volunteers. The estimable Susan Corner will be coordinating the reception committee.

There will be a training session for volunteers this Wednesday, August 22, at 7 p.m. in the lower Greenan Center. I hope that you will consider jumping in to help with this most necessary effort, about which more will be said in the coming couple of months.
