From the Pastor

Last week we got the final report on the Catholic Charity Fund appeal and at last I can share the news with you. Our goal this year was \$110,000; we raised \$120,017, i.e. 109.11% of our goal. Four hundred sixteen people/households participated, which represents 22.33% of all registered households. The gifts ranged from \$10 to \$10,000 per donor. Since the drive ended, we received another gift of \$6,000 from a will, which I requested be counted toward next year's goal. The diocesan goal of \$8,000,000 was not quite reached, but that was not due to any lack of generosity here at St. Francis.

First of all, our thanks go to Gerri Marsocci, our coordinator, ably assisted by Michelle Neilson. Their labors on behalf of this worthy effort were key to our success and I cannot thank them enough for all their work behind the scenes.

Of course, it was you, the parishioners, who ultimately put us over the top. God bless you for your generous support of this appeal, which allows the Church to carry on its work, especially to those in need, no matter what their race or religion.
