

# From the Pastor,

Here is a thought from a great 19<sup>th</sup> century convert to Catholicism, Blessed John Henry (Cardinal) Newman, on our Lord's admonition that we heard on the first Sunday of Advent, "Watch, therefore; you do not know when the Lord of the house in coming."

"Jesus knew his own purpose and his Father's purpose gradually to leave the world to itself. He contemplated the neglect of him which would spread even among his professed followers; the daring disobedience and the loud words, which would be ventured against him and his Father by many whom he had regenerated: and the coldness, cowardice, and tolerance of error which would be displayed by others, who did not go so far as to speak against him. He foresaw the state of the world and the Church, as we see it this day, when his prolonged absence has made it practically thought that he never will come back in visible presence. And in the text he mercifully whispers into our ears not to trust what we see, not to share in that general unbelief, not be carried away by the world, but to take heed, watch, pray, and look out for his coming."
