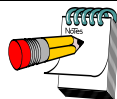

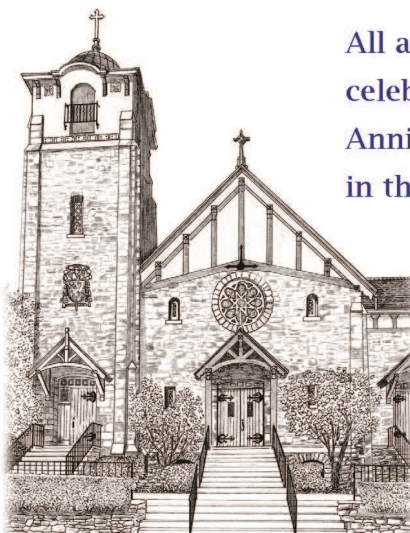

## *From the Pastor,*

We have two occasions for excitement in the parish next weekend. The first is my 40<sup>th</sup> anniversary Mass at noon next Sunday, followed by a reception in the Father Greenan Center. I can't thank enough all those who are working on the music, the liturgy, and the reception: It's above and beyond the call of duty. You might plan on getting here a bit earlier than usual if you want a parking space near the church.

The second, about which I am more excited, is the arrival of Fr. Philip Dufour as our assistant pastor for the summer. By the time you read this, he will have been ordained a priest by Bishop Tobin. His "First Mass of Thanksgiving" will take at 2 p.m. this Sunday (today, for those reading this on Sunday) at his home parish of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel in Bristol, where our parishioner Fr. Stephen Battey is the assistant pastor. Fr. Dufour will be with us through Labor Day weekend and then will return to Rome for one year to complete his "license" in sacred theology (S.T.L.). I hope you will join me in making him feel welcome to our community.

This week we celebrate the symbolic date of the founding of our country, the day on which the Declaration of Independence was signed. If we had not won an 8-year-long war, the Declaration would have been worthless and perhaps slid under the waves of history.

We are still working on being a democratic republic "with liberty and justice for all," and we have weathered grave threats to our survival, the most dangerous being the secession of the southern states in order to preserve the institution of slavery and the concomitant civil war. We are known as a practical people. I hope and pray that we never turn our backs on the democratic process just because things can be done more efficiently by an unfettered monarch. I also would call the Left to remember what happened in Germany and Italy in the last century: their own excesses provoked a reaction from the Right that did not end well for anyone.

America, America! God mend thine every flaw, confirm thy soul in self-control, thy liberty in law.

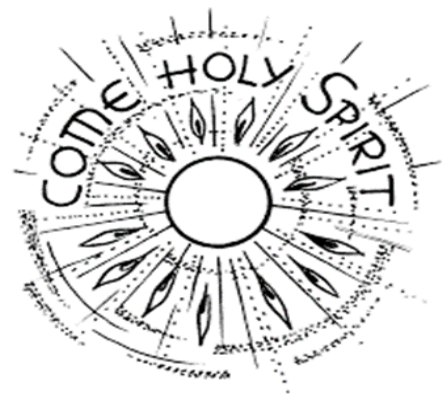


### **RELIGIOUS EDUCATION CLASSES**

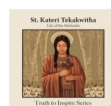
