

From the Pastor,

The last report from the Catholic Charities Fund appeal came in a few days ago. We exceeded our goal by \$12,984.82, or to put in another way: we raised 111.29% of our goal of \$115,000. There were 438 gifts and pledges made, which represents one quarter of all registered households. The average gift was \$328.17, but the pledges ranged from \$10,000 down to a few dollars. We also received a gift of over \$6,000 from the estate of a loyal parishioner who has gone to her eternal reward. Since we went over our goal, approximately \$8,992.00 will come back to the parish.

I can't thank Gerri Marsocci enough for all her work on this effort. She has been coordinating Catholic Charity appeals for 49 years in two parishes and we wish her many more fruitful years to come. She was ably assisted by Michele Nielson and by our faithful parish secretary, Jacki Hunt. God bless them for all the time and effort they put into this worthy cause. So many people are helped and so many agencies are supported by the work of Catholic Charities. I pray that all who participated in this work will not go without their reward.
