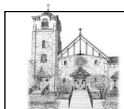

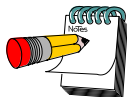

Speaking of feasts: a week from Monday will be the feast of St. Romuald on June 19. Instead of adoration in the parish church that day, we'll have a special Mass at noon at the chapel, in addition to the 7 a.m. in the church.

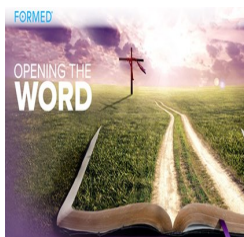
