

From the Pastor,

We are all concerned about the situation with the immigrants and refugees on our southern border, most of whom are our fellow Catholics. The present administration's policy of strict enforcement of the pre-existing laws is nothing short of draconian, and the congress lacks the will—or the spine—to pass any reform of our inadequate legislation. Several people of our area, Christian and Jewish, have met to see how, as people of faith, we can address this issue. Here is what they have come up with, which I have tweaked a little for our bulletin:

We have been hearing recently about the separation of immigrant children from their families at the U.S.-Mexico border. As followers of Christ, and as Catholics with pro-life and pro-family values, we must speak out against this. One of our parishioners has helped to set up an interfaith postcardwriting event on Wednesday, June 27, from 4:30-6:30 at the Peace Dale Village Green (1058 Kingstown Rd.). Come write a postcard to voice your opposition. Each postcard will raise \$5 for RAICES, a non-profit that provides free/low-cost legal services to immigrant children, parents, families, and refugees in Texas. Some postcards and stamps will be available, or bring your own. This is a kid-friendly event. For more information, contact Adrienne Daly at 504-897-5387.

This is not meant primarily as a political event. There can be legitimate differences among us on what our immigration laws and policies should look like. This is a protest by free citizens at the implementation of laws which shows such little respect for family values and the dignity of the human person.


