
This week's sanctuary lamp at St. Francis Church burns in memory of James W. Smith.

From the Pastor

Next weekend, I'll have the pleasure of introducing the young priest who will be with us for the months of July and August while he's home from Rome for a break from his study of Canon Law. Fr. Nathan Ricci grew up in St. Catherine's parish in the Apponaug section of Warwick and did his theological formation at the Pontifical North American College in Rome. Usually, theological bachelor degrees are finished in three years but the seminary has a four-year formation program. In my day, those of us who were at pontifical universities would start taking courses for the next degree but were never allowed to finish since the seminary program was done and we were expected home for ordination and a parish assignment.

In later years the diocese began assigning the students in Rome to come home for ordination after their fourth year but then to return for another year of studies to finish their "Licentiate" in some branch of theology or canon law. So, although Fr. Ricci was ordained last year, this will be his first parish assignment. I hope you will join me in welcoming him among us.


