# From the Pastor

Another year of religious education has come to a close. My sincere thanks to Barbette Cullen and Diane Castro, who direct and coordinate a program that runs from kindergarten through 9<sup>th</sup>-grade confirmation and that includes a Sunday liturgy of the word for children from 4 to 8 years of age. Diane Castro also prepares and oversees the post-confirmation youth program of the parish. Of course, they cannot and do not run these programs alone: a whole cadre of teachers and other volunteers, including some of high-school age, make the whole thing possible, and we cannot express our thanks enough to them for this commitment of time, talent and energy. The next phase of religious education will begin this summer as the rising 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> graders will come for five days of 3.5 hour sessions each in preparation for the sacrament of confirmation. This process will continue throughout next academic year with monthly youth gatherings for all teens of the parish.

As I have so often mentioned in this column, the parish runs largely on volunteer help, who assist a minimum of paid staff members. From weeding the gardens to bringing communion to the sick and shut-in, from religious education to weekend liturgy, we could not survive without the commitment of so many who volunteer their help. In this parish, there are nearly 300 people who do something over and above attending Mass to keep the parish functioning.

Let me issue a special invitation to the parishioners between 25 and 50 years of age not to be left out. Step up and help keep this a true Christian community. God bless the work!

Next Saturday, May 13, marks the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the first appearance of our Lady at Fatima, Portugal. It is in commemorations of these apparitions, which ran from May to October of 1917 that we are celebrating "A Year with Mary, our Mother." Various celebrations are being held around the diocese such as the one next Saturday at the cathedral, about which there is an announcement in this bulletin.
