

From the Pastor,

We'd like to start a series to prepare adults to be baptized, or to be welcomed into the Catholic Church, or to receive Confirmation or First Communion. The shorthand name for this process is RCIA, the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults. Although that refers to adults who would like to be baptized, it has become also the outline of the preparation for any adult who is not yet fully initiated into the Catholic faith.

Joining this group does not commit someone to becoming a Catholic; that decision will be made as the process unfolds. But if you know someone—a spouse, a relative, a friend, a neighbor—who might be interested in becoming a Catholic, or is a Catholic who has never received Confirmation, please tell them about the first meeting of the RCIA group in the rectory next month on Thursday, October 12, at 7 p.m. Remember the words of the Lord at the conclusion of Matthew's gospel: *"Go into all the world and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold! I am with you always until the end of the age."*


