

# From the Pastor,


Last weekend our parish hosted our semi-annual marriage preparation program. Although this is a diocesan program, it is organized and staffed by couples from our parish. John and Patty Grimes coordinate the Friday evening to Saturday afternoon schedule and are ably assisted by Ryan and Jen Bernard, Rich and Mary McQuarrie, Chris and Teresa O'Brien, Steve and Jill Sabo, and Bryan and Sue Williams. The topics range from communication to financial planning, from Natural Family Planning to dealing with differences of personality and family background to the sacramental nature of marriage.

One thing that always comes across in the evaluation responses from the engaged couples is how much they value the witness of the married couples and their many years together. Mary and Rich were not able to be with us this time, so the diocese arranged to have Professor Matthew Cuddeback from Providence College give the talk on Natural Family Planning. A number of the attendees reported that they found this topic very enlightening. They also were reminded that, although Catholic teaching excludes the use of artificial contraception within marriage, it encourages natural means of family planning and the regulation of births to achieve responsible parenthood.

The engaged couples expressed their appreciation on their evaluation forms and gave a number of helpful recommendations for future sessions. I wish space permitted me to quote their words since they all expressed how grateful they are for this chance to learn about Catholic teaching, hear the witness of the married couples, and have an opportunity to discuss issues with their fiancé (e)s before their wedding days.




