### From the Pastor...

Last Monday we celebrated **First Penance** for forty-seven children of our parish. Although they were a little jittery about going to confession for the first time, the children were well prepared and did very well. I thank Mrs. Cullen, their teachers and parents for helping to prepare them for this important sacrament. Now they will focus on preparing to receive their **First Holy Communion** in the Spring.

Speaking of going to confession, receiving this sacrament of forgiveness and renewal is a great way to prepare for Christmas during the Advent Season. In the past we have had an Advent Penance Service, but it has not been well attended. I think that, given all the events and activities of this season, many people who would like to receive the sacrament of penance, are simply not available to join us for an extended service on a particular evening. So this year we are going to try something different. On Monday evening, December 23, there will be a priest available for Confession in the reconciliation room (to the right of the altar in the sanctuary) from 5:00 PM to 7:00 PM. Our thought is that this will provide the opportunity to just stop in for a short time, perhaps on the way home from work, to receive the sacrament. Of course we will also have confessions on Saturday afternoon from 3:30 to 4:00 PM as we do every week.

I'm sure everyone is very busy preparing for Christmas...don't forget what it is really about. Be sure to take advantage of this Advent Season to pray a little more and to welcome the Lord into your life!
