



From the Pastor...

Recently we received a notification from the Bishop's Office asking all the parishes to consider taking a special collection to assist the victims of the **Tornadoes in Oklahoma**. I'm sure that everyone saw the news reports of the destruction and devastation left in the wake of the tornadoes. It is hard to imagine having entire neighborhoods total wiped out and families left with nothing but the clothes on their backs. It is a harsh reality that happened very quickly. Therefore, in response to this appeal, **we will take a special collection next weekend, June 29-30 at all the Masses**. There is no envelope for this collection so you are invited to make a loose donation of cash or check made out to St. Francis Church. It is our way of helping our neighbors in need.

This coming week I will be participating in the annual reunion of **The American College of the Catholic University of Louvain, Belgium**. That is the seminary I attended many years ago! Last summer I was asked to coordinate the reunion to take place in Providence and, in a weak moment, I agreed to do it. There are over 45 priests of our diocese who are Louvain alumni. Many of them will be joining with other alumni from around the country to renew acquaintances and enjoy a few days together. We are expecting 125 participants for our Alumni Memorial Mass and banquet to take place at the Aldrich Mansion on Warwick Neck. Also, in observance of the 50th Anniversary of Vatican II, **the American College Alumni Association is sponsoring a public presentation on Thursday evening, June 27, at 7:00 PM in the theater at LaSalle Academy in Providence. Father Joseph Komonchak, a noted scholar, will present "Reflections on the Second Vatican Council". Admission is free and all are welcome to attend.**


