Fr. Joe has finished his move out of the rectory although it will no doubt take some time before he feels at home in his new digs. We wish him all the best in his new ministry, so important for the future of the Church in our state and our country.

Here at St. Francis, we begin a new era, the first without a second priest. I hope to write to everyone in a few weeks, outlining the new programs and efforts that are being planned for the near and the not-so-near future.

On July 6, we begin the new confirmation program. The students will do all their catechesis during one of two weeks in the summer.
