Corpus Christ: The Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Jesus

As we reflect today on the presence of Jesus in the Eucharist, we are reminded that the Mass is the source and summit of the Christian life. Everything we do and everything we are should be shaped and informed by our weekly worship of God. Today's solemnity provides an opportunity for us to reflect on the possibility of committing to a liturgical ministry to aid our community in the worship of God. Please read through the following descriptions and prayerfully consider the possibility of serving as a reader or an extraordinary minister of Holy Communion.

Proclaiming God's Word: A Call for New Readers

We are accustomed to the power of words they can harm or help, hurt or heal. Imagine how much more powerful is *God's* Word. The Second Vatican Council taught that when the Scriptures are proclaimed at Mass, God himself is speaking to his people. Why



not consider allowing God to use **YOU** as he proclaims his Word to his people? By serving as a **Reader** at Mass, you assume the role of the Old Testament prophets, allowing God's Word to be heard by a people starving for Good News. The requirements are simple: candidates must be Confirmed, practicing Catholics in good standing and be willing to read aloud audibly and clearly in front of a crowd. Training sessions will be offered to familiarize new readers with the microphone and the liturgical books. Workbooks with commentary on the readings, pronunciation guides, and proclamation pointers are provided for each reader. In order to have enough coverage for each Mass, including back-up replacements, <u>more readers are especially</u> <u>needed at this time</u>. Please speak with one of our parish clergy to learn more about the possibility of serving in this important role.



An Office of Immense Love: A Call for New Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion

From week to week, Jesus feeds us with his Body and Blood. Due to the large number of communicants, *Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion* assist the parish clergy in distributing Communion to the faithful at each parish Mass. Pope Paul VI once called this important role an *"office of immense love."* We are looking for Confirmed, practicing Catholics in good

standing—with a deep devotion to Jesus in the Eucharist—to assist with this important ministry. Training sessions will be offered to familiarize candidates with the procedures and practicalities of this ministry. Because we will soon resume the distribution of the Precious Blood at parish Masses, <u>an additional number of Extraordinary Ministers will be required for scheduling</u>. Please speak with one of our parish clergy to learn more about the possibility of serving in this important role.



Registration for 2013/2014 Religious Education Classes is now open. Any families new to our parish need to register their children for fall classes. Our First Communion program is a two year formation registration for public school students starting in Grade 1. Catholic School elementary students must register Grade are if they entering 2 Confirmation registration is required for those new students or Catholic school students who will be entering Grade 9 this Fall.

Students currently enrolled in the program DO NOT need to re-register.

- Read Chapter 6 of the Gospel of Saint John to learn about Jesus' own teaching on his Eucharistic presence.
- Read paragraphs 1406-1419 of the Catechism of the Catholic Church.
