The Return to Ordinary Time...

After many weeks of celebrating the Easter mystery, we returned to the season of "Ordinary Time" on the Monday after Pentecost a few weeks ago. However, this is the first *Sunday* that we return to the familiar green vestments and regular cycle of readings. Spend some time this week reflecting on the meaning of this season.

- Ordinary Time is the season of the Church year when Catholics are encouraged to grow and mature in daily expression of their faith outside the great seasons of celebration of Christmas and Easter and the great periods of penance of Advent and Lent.
- Ordinary Time is a time to deepen one's prayer life, read the Scriptures, unite more deeply with the Lord in the Eucharist and become a more holy and whole person.
- Ordinary Time is a period when average people like you and me strive to become the extraordinary messengers of the Gospel that we have been commissioned to be through our Baptism.
- Ordinary Time is this day, this moment. Now.

Here are some suggestions to help you observe the season of Ordinary Time, which stretches through the summer:

- 1) **Keep a gratitude journal:** on a daily basis, write down a blessing from God that you are grateful for. When you come to Mass on Sunday, reflect on your list in prayer.
- 2) **Act out:** take advantage of our parish summer programming in education or spirituality, or spend some time volunteering
- 3) **Expand your knowledge:** find a great Catholic book to take with you to the beach and expand your knowledge of our faith (Fr. Randall has great recommendations!)
