From the Pastor

Last summer, Fr. Joe had a reading group or book club, open to all, that met in three sessions to discuss Scott Hahn's Evangelizing Catholics, a call to implement what is called "the new evangelization." From this group was formed an evangelizing committee to address ways in which a new enthusiasm for Christian living might be fomented, especially among those who have ceased to practice the Faith. The first idea proposed was to have a parish survey to gather information about how people saw the parish and what direction we should try to go in to ensure a solid future for our community. Did anyone realize how complex and time-consuming this process would be? Our great thanks first to Fr. Joe, who spearheaded the formation of a questionnaire, and then to the members of the committee, who spent many hours reading, collating, and processing all the data and comments from the forms. I am happy to report that the data was collected not just from people who are regularly here for weekend Masses, but also from those who are less involved. The committee has not yet finished its labors, but enough data has been processed to allow us to make a report to the parishioners, which you heard at Masses this weekend.

A second effort has also come forth from the original reading group, one that I urge everyone to publicize and support. It's called Catholics Anonymous and is composed of concerned parishioners who want to engage in conversation with their fellow Catholics, especially those who have given up attending Mass regularly or who may have a gripe against the Church. This is an informal effort to listen and converse, not to argue or convert. Please help spread the word to your neighbors and friends and invite them to Panera restaurant this Wednesday, May 27, at 7pm for conversation with fellow lay Catholics.


