# From the Pastor...

Last weekend we concluded the Easter Season with the celebration of **Pentecost**, recalling the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. Our parish celebration was enhanced by the fact that three adults of our parish received the gifts of the Holy Spirit through the **Sacrament of Confirmation**. I congratulate **Tracy McNulty**, **Jackie McCormick and Katie Sargis** on their Confirmation and I ask you to join me in praying that the Spirit will continue to bless and guide them in their lives of faith.

Next Saturday at the Cathedral of Saints Peter and Paul in Providence, our diocese will celebrate the ordination of two men to the priesthood. Scott Carpentier from St. Agatha Parish in Woonsocket and Thomas Woodhouse from St. Paul Parish in Cranston will be ordained by Bishop Tobin. I ask your prayers for them as they begin their priestly ministry and for all our diocesan seminarians as they continue their preparation for the priesthood. # NEXT WEEK IS THE SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST (CORPUS CHRISTI).

Both the 10:00AM and 12:00NN Masses at Saint Francis will conclude with Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament. The Rite of Benediction—during which the celebrant blesses the congregation with the consecrated host (contained in an ornate vessel called a "monstrance")— is an act of worship which flows from



the Mass and leads back to it. If we are able to *adore* Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament, we become able to *receive him more worthily* in Holy Communion. Saint Augustine once said in regard to the Eucharist: "Let no one eat until he has first adored." For those who may be adversely affected, *incense* will be used at these ceremonies.



Registration for 2013/2014 Religious Education Classes is now open. Any families new to our parish need to register their children for fall classes. Our First Communion program is a two year formation registration for public school students starting in Grade 1. Catholic School elementary students must register if they are entering Grade 2.

Confirmation registration is required for those new students or Catholic school students who will be entering Grade 9 this Fall.

# Students currently enrolled in the program DO NOT need to re-register.


