A Light Unto My Path

Fifth Sunday of Easter

For Buddhists, the Buddha is a great teacher and moral exemplar. He had found an eightfold path that led him to spiritual liberation, and he wanted to share that wisdom with his followers. Muslims, Mohammed is the great prophet through whom the definitive revelation of Allah was given and in whom the rightly ordered life is displayed. For Confucians, Confucius is the definitive instructor in the moral life. By attending to his precepts, they believe they will live well and in attunement with both society and the cosmos.

And then there is Jesus. Jesus is indeed teacher, wisdom figure, and moral exemplar; but none of these titles come close to naming the fullness of what Christ means to Christians. He is, in his own person, the divine life, and hence he is, as Saint John specifies, the vine onto which his disciples are grafted and through which they participate in God. This is why, at the climax of his life, Jesus does not offer his followers simply a final spiritual instruction, but rather his Body and Blood, which he invites them to consume. And this is why Saint Paul refers to the Church not as a society of like-minded people, but as the very Body of [Christ].


