From the Pastor

Many, many thanks to all involved in last week's Pasta Dinner. One of the coordinators, when I asked for a list of those on the committee, warned me that mentioning names is dangerous since someone is sure to be overlooked. True enough. So just let me say that I realize that it took weeks of preparation and much generous donation of articles for the baskets and for the dinner itself in addition to the more intense labor to prepare, cook and serve the food and to clean up afterwards. Nearly 300 people attended including our pastor emeritus, Fr. Nick Smith, always a welcome visitor. Again, my sincere thanks to all who helped make this such an enjoyable evening.

Elsewhere in the news, we took a count of attendees at Mass for the last two weekends to report to the diocese. There were just over 1000 the first weekend and around 960 the second. What skews the statistics of course is the number of people, especially from outside the parish boundaries, who registered here at some point but who do not support us by their presence, the most valuable contribution one can make to parish life. My opinion is that the parish is responsible for serving all the Catholics in our territory whether they be registered or not and whether they come to Mass or not—although I would beg them to register with us and of course to attend Mass. In addition we also have many loyal parishioners from outside the parish territory who give generously of their time and talent, or who continue to support us financially when they can no longer get to Mass.

It's the third group I have a problem with: those who neither live in the parish territory nor participate in any way in the parish life but somehow have their names on our parish lists. Hmmm.
