From the Pastor,

A few months ago, I wrote a short piece on Fr. Greenan, in whose honor our parish center is named.

The hall downstairs in the church is named in memory of Helen Bouchard, several members of whose family still live in the parish. Here are some notes passed on to me by her son Mike:

Helen Rosina Murney was the eighth of nine children whose mother died when Helen was very young. Her father never remarried and the younger children were cared for and raised by their father an older siblings. Her parents and grandparents are buried here in South Kingstown. After high school she worked as a secretary at URI for 8 years.

At the end of World War II, Helen, already a life-long member of St. Francis of Assisi Parish, married Romauld Bouchard, an army Master Sergeant from Frenchville, Maine, stationed in southern Rhode Island. Romauld became a Postal Clerk in Wakefield and by 1958 the couple had five sons and one daughter, their youngest.

Helen remained at home nurturing and supporting the family until the late 1960's when all the children were in, or past, grade school.

Helen then began what became a career as a teaching assistant at several early childcare facilities in South Kingstown until becoming an elementary school library assistant with the South Kingstown School Department from which she retired in the early 1980's.

Tragically, in June of 1984, Helen died suddenly as the result of an auto accident just before leaving for home from the out of state wedding of a relative.

At Romauld's request, in lieu of flowers, friends and family contributed to the renovation of the lower church which was later dedicated as Helen Bouchard Hall

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION


A heartfelt thank you to the many hands who helped to make our First Communion Day so beautiful for our 16 Families.


