# From the Pastor,

To continue some statistics about our diocese taken from the RI Catholic:

- ◆ In 2018, 103,315 people were assisted by diocesan social services that provided outreach to the homeless, legal services, counseling, legal services, food pantries and soup kitchens.
- Since 2013, \$450,000 has been raised from the Lumen Gentium Awards dinner that supports ministries throughout the Diocese. The awards honor people for their commitment t and service to the Church and the community. (Our own Bill Harding was one of the first to be so honored.)
- ◆ The Diocese operates two top-rated nursing facilities (360 beds) and an assisted-living facility (76 beds), providing both short-term rehabilitation and long-term care for those who can no longer live alone.

Here in our area, our local chapter of the St. Vincent de Paul Society distributes aid to people and families facing emergency needs. The members have made 81 home visits since they began a year ago and have distributed \$18,848.50 in direct aid and another \$1,490.95 in gift cards and vouchers.

God bless everyone who puts something into the St. Vincent de Paul boxes at the doors of the church and chapel or who contributes to the "Monthly Collection," three of which annually goes to this valiant effort.


