



("Nada te turbe/Nada t'espante/Todo se pasa/Dios no se muda./La paciencia todo lo alcanza./Quien a Dios tiene/Nada le falta./ Solo Dios basta.")

protection, so that by your help and example, we may lead a holy life, die a happy death, and come to possess eternal life in heaven. Amen.






