

So, although we cannot gather in the church as a community we are celebrating the Mass every day and putting it up on Facebook and on our parish website: stfranciswakefield.com

This week, the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper will be celebrated on Holy Thursday at 5 p.m. and, again, this is not open to the public but will be available on the sites mentioned above.

On Good Friday, the Service of the Lord's Passion will be celebrated at 3 pm. in place of the usual Stations of the Cross which would be too difficult to tape.
