



# From the Pastor,

This weekend was supposed to celebrate two significant events in our parish. On Saturday, May 2, our parishioner and seminarian Daniel Mahoney was to be ordained a deacon as the penultimate step toward the priesthood. Now the ordination has been postponed till sometime in the fall. Our prayers are with Dan and his classmates as they face this disappointment. I believe that this little bit of suffering, this temporary setback, is a sign that Dan's ministry will be blessed with great fruitfulness for the People of God. As it says in the Acts of the Apostles: "It is necessary for us to undergo many hardships to enter the kingdom of God." Dan is in our prayers as he makes his way toward the priesthood in spite of such obstacles.

Sunday, May 3, was supposed to be First Communion day for our children. They and their families, too, have faced the disappointment of postponement of this significant milestone. As soon as we know when this crisis is past, we'll be able to reschedule this celebration. In the meantime, they'll have to watch the Mass on the computer and make a spiritual communion like their fellow Catholics.

The last Saturday of May was supposed to see the celebration of Confirmation in our parish. Alas, that too has been indefinitely postponed. We're thankful that we had already petitioned for another Confirmation date in November because we are slowly lowering the age of confirmation to conform to a growing trend, so if all goes well, the 9<sup>th</sup> graders, who would have been confirmed this month, will be able to join the 8<sup>th</sup> graders in the fall. Let's pray that there is not another flare-up of this virus at that time of the year.

May is the month of Our Lady and for many years Bill Harding has led the rosary and litany every weeknight of May at the chapel. It's grievous that we cannot gather for these services until this health crisis is over, but I will put the Litany of Loreto on the computer every weekday around 11:30 a.m. so we can be united in prayer for our blessed Mother's intercession. Health of the Sick, pray for us!
