

From the Pastor,

The climax of the Easter Season is upon us. Pentecost Sunday celebrates the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the followers of Christ as he had descended upon the human nature of Jesus at the baptism at the Jordan River. Between the feasts of the Ascension and Pentecost we pray in a special way that we become more open to the will of the Father, more committed to the imitation of Christ, more empowered to bear witness to the gospel.

As I write this (on Monday), we are preparing to begin the reopening of the churches to public worship in a limited way. If all goes well and there is no flare-up of infection, we can begin slowly to work toward adding Masses to the schedule. Right now, I know that there are many loyal Catholics who are not yet ready to return to mingling with others in a public setting. I support their decision, as does our bishop, who has reassured us that we are dispensed from the obligation to attend weekend Mass while we are still in the midst of this world-wide epidemic. I would ask those who are ready to return to public worship to be patient with us as we try to navigate this unprecedented situation. And I would encourage those who are elderly or have some underlying condition please to stay home and follow the Mass on our Facebook page (stfranciswakefield) or parish website (stfranciswakefield.com), where we will continue to live-stream both the Sunday and the weekday Masses for the foreseeable future.

In any case, whether in church or at home, we can all rejoice that we have been given the same Holy Spirit who lives with the Father and the Son from all eternity and who was poured out upon the human nature of Jesus. We have been made children of God, sons and daughters in the Son, sharers in the divine life. We have also been anointed to go forth and bear witness to Christ in a world always out of kilter and resistant to the demands of the gospel yet which longs for what only God can give.

Come, Holy Spirit. Fill the hearts of thy faithful and enkindle in them the fire of thy love!
