





From the Pastor,

First of all, a great "thank you" to those who helped with the reopening of the church and the chapel last weekend. We couldn't have done it without you! This weekend it should go even more smoothly now that people have had a chance to experience the "new normal." I need to repeat that the Masses are at 8 a.m. at the chapel and at 9:30 at the church, and to remind everyone that when we are able to implement the full schedule, the Sunday morning Masses at the church will be at 9 and 11 only; no more 8, 10 and noon.

Also, I join the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops and all people of good will in denouncing the sin of racism that is so endemic in our society. (The full statement from the USCCB can be found here: http://www.usccb.org/news/2020/20-83.cfm)

I'm afraid that until white Americans can see the problem, it will never be solved. How many of us are completely blind to the double standard of justice as it is applied to whites and to members of racial minorities? The resentment of this injustice are becoming more and more open and violent, especially when even peaceful protest is condemned as unacceptable, and simply trying to suppress the outrage with similar violence will not lead to any kind of real solution. Education leading to radical repentance and a change of heart are the only things that can bring healing to our society. Are we Christians followers of Christ or not?


