



## AUGUST 30, 2020

## From the Pastor,

Labor Day weekend is almost here and we'll be returning to the winter schedule: church Masses at 9 and 11 a.m.; chapel Mass at 10 only. I hope to resume the 4:30 Mass on Saturday but only after Columbus Day. So far, I have not received a single request to bring the Saturday evening Mass back, and it does attract an older cohort, who should probably not be mingling with crowds anyway

In order to resume the Saturday evening Mass we would need people to volunteer as 1) greeters to welcome people, make sure they sanitize their hands, remind them of where to sit in the church, and close the doors when seating capacity is reached; and 2) people to take turns spending a little less than 10 minutes after Mass each Saturday to sanitize the pews and kneelers with spray and wipe down the door knobs and crash bars with sanitizing wipes. If we can't get volunteers for these duties, we cannot have the Mass. Also, if we cannot get a decent size congregation together, it might not be worth having. It's would be grievous to assemble a cohort of greeters, readers, servers, Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, and sanitizers and then have only a dozen people in the congregation. So let me know and we'll see if we can recommence on October 17.

I could take this opportunity to remind people with underlying conditions—including advanced age—to consider staying home during this health crisis. If you're troubled about missing Mass, please remember that the bishop has specifically dispensed everyone from the obligation to attend while this pandemic lasts.

### 2020-2021 Religious Education Start Up

With the pandemic still with us we want to re-start the year

safely and wisely. At this time, all children in **Grades 1-6** will start the year with distance learning until the beginning of November. **Grades 7 & 8** will be preparing for Confirmation and their classes will be a **hybrid** of in person and virtual. #### **Catechetical Sunday**

The Religious Education year begins on Catechetical Sunday, September 20<sup>th</sup>.

On Catechetical Sunday we will have a **RE Family Faith on the Go Event.** Each family with children in Grades 1-6 will be given a time to come to the church parking lot (*remain in their cars*) and pick up Religious Ed materials for their family. Masked and gloved volunteers will hand each family the materials needed for their child's distance learning for the next few months. **In November** we will reassess the need for distance learning for Grades 1-6. Children in Grade 7 will receive their student workbook at their first in person class on October 7<sup>th</sup> while Grade 8 will receive their materials on October 14<sup>th</sup>.



#### **Registration for Classes**

Those families **new** to the parish and families with children entering First Grade **must** register for classes. Families with children

in Catholic school in Grade 2 and Grades 7 & 8 must register for First Holy Communion and Confirmation.




