

First Sunday of each month.


SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY

From the Pastor,

Just a reminder of a couple of things that I hope will allow us to welcome more people to weekend Masses at our parish church: 1) the 9:00 a.m. Mass will be broadcast to the Helen Bouchard Hall in the lower church beginning this weekend for the sake of people who cannot get into the church; 2) at the 11 a.m. Mass, the sound system will carry the audio of the Mass to the hall downstairs even though the video will not be available; 3) the Saturday 4:30 p.m. Mass will resume on October 17. In all these ways, we hope to accommodate those who otherwise have not been able to get into the church. We need a few more people who are willing to be greeters at the 4:30 and the 11 or "sanitizers" after the 4:30. Without this help, we cannot forge ahead with the planned schedule. I'd like to renew our invitation to those who have not been able to receive communion since the shut-down in March. Holy Communion will be available from 12:30 to 1 p.m. in the parking lot of the church next Sunday, October 18. Please don't forget to register ahead of time by leaving your name and contact information at 401-588-4192. There is more information in the announcement elsewhere in this bulletin.

Please pray for our 10th grade confirmation candidates and their sponsors and families. Because the bishop has granted delegation to the pastors of the diocese, I shall confer the sacrament at 11 a.m. this Saturday, October 17.

There has been a request to recommence weekly Exposition and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. I'll prepare a sign-up sheet for time slots on Monday mornings in half-hour increments. If we get enough people to cover the hours from 7:30 to noon, I hope we can begin again in November. I also need someone who would be willing to act as the contact person who can look for replacements in case someone can't make his or her chosen time. Please call the rectory if you're willing to assume this small responsibility.

HOLY COMMUNION



For anyone who has been uncomfortable or unable to attend Mass, there will be a drive up, remain in your car, distribution of Holy Communion *next Sunday, October 18th beginning at 12:30 pm* in the main Church parking lot. You are not obligated to receive Communion, use judgment on your own vulnerability. Please remain home if you are experiencing any symptoms or are ill.

In preparation, watch the 9am live-streamed Mass at the parish web site or review the readings, which are also available at www.usccb.org . Fast from food or drink for an hour before arrival.

Last names A-J are asked to arrive at 12:30 and K-Z at 12:45 pm. Wear masks; enter the parking lot on Winter Street and exit on High Street. Please bring your own hand sanitizer.

<u>If you plan to participate</u> or have any questions, call, or text 401-588-4192 and leave your name, contact information and the number who will be receiving Communion.
