



# From the Pastor,

First of all, a very happy beginning of a new liturgical year to everyone! Let's hope that the coming year goes more smoothly than the one that's ending now and that in the next some months we'll be able to resume a more "normal" routine.

We're about to break new ground here at St. Francis. As you know, thanks to the skill and generosity of our loyal parishioner Ryan Bernard, we've been able to livestream the Sunday 9 o'clock Mass as well as Holy Week and several other services that have taken place since the shut-down. Now it's agreed that it is time to take the next step and install a more permanent camera that will work on a pre-programmed schedule to do the livestreaming. This should not only improve the quality of the broadcast, which is certainly more than adequate already, but free Ryan to attend Mass with the congregation and with his wife, Jen, whenever she is not obliged to play the organ at Mass.

We have also retained the services of a technician who is giving us a break on the installation of this camera and its programming since it is for use with divine worship. Still, it is going to cost something up toward \$3,000. In addition, because of a change in federal guidelines about frequencies for microphone use, last year we had to install a new system in the church; this year, we had to do the chapel and the extra mic used at the church, mostly by the deacon but also at very other services throughout the year.. I'm steeling myself for that bill, which hasn't come in yet.

I have not been making an issue about financial giving because I know that people are out of work or on reduced work schedules, but if anyone is able to and interested in helping to defray the cost of these new amenities, please let me know. I should think it would be especially attractive to those who have been watching from home.


