



From the Pastor,

We are gearing up for Christmas and have no idea how many people will try to attend Mass. A couple of parishioners kindly offered to coordinate a pre-registration program, but I demurred. I know that no matter what efforts we would make, some people wouldn't get the message that they'd have to register ahead of time and would be offended by being turned away, even if they arrived in plenty of time. So, we'll have to wait and see. I would love to see the church and chapel full, but during this pandemic, it is not to be. Social-distancing must still be observed, and that limits the number of people that can fit in the spaces available. We'll be live-streaming the 4:30 Christmas eve Mass, and those who cannot fit into the church can watch the Mass from downstairs in the Helen Bouchard Hall or from the Greenan Center, as well as from home at our Facebook site or from our parish website: stfranciswakefield.com. Despite my desire to see everyone filling the churches, I really must recommend that people of more advanced age, people with underlying medical conditions, or those with at-risk people at home, really think twice about coming out to Mass.

If you are registered in the parish, you should have received a postcard with the Mass schedule and the reference to the website. If you cannot be here in person, please join us by video and in the spirit of Christmas. God bless us every one!

Weekly coloring pages: to be emailed to Mrs. Cullen.



Just a reminder that our St. Vincent de Paul chapter here at St. Francis needs your help. They ask your help by using their poor boxes located in the church and


