

# From the Pastor,

Many thanks to those who arranged and worked at the "parking lot communion" we had last Sunday. The weather was more than cooperative-- it was like a mild spring day—and 25 vehicles of parishioners had registered to take advantage of this opportunity to receive Our Lord in Holy Communion. God bless all who helped with this event!

Now we're entering the last week of Advent and by this time next week Christmas Day will have passed and we'll be celebrating the Feast of the Holy Family. In the meantime, it remains to be seen what Christmas will look like this year in our homes and families. We are all still being urged to be very careful of our own health and the health of others by mingling as little as possible with people we don't actually live with. So, let's do the best we can.

Masses in our parish will be held in the parish church at 4:30 p.m. and 10:00 p.m. on Christmas Eve and at 9 a.m. and 11 a.m. on Christmas Day. Masses at the chapel will be at 5:30 p.m. on Christmas Eve and at 10:00 a.m. on Christmas Day. The 4:30 Christmas Eve Mass will be live-streamed and will be available for viewing on our Facebook page and on our parish website: stfranciswakefield.com. Any overflow crowd at the church on Christmas Eve can be seated downstairs in Helen Bouchard Hall or in the Father Greenan Center. Alas, there is no place to put any overflow at the chapel except out on the deck on the west side of the building. I would once again encourage people who are of advanced age or who have underlying medical conditions to consider watching the Mass from home or coming on Christmas morning rather than the evening before. I know this will be a sacrifice for some but will free up places for our younger parishioners, especially the children. Christmas morning will not be as likely to attract larger crowds, so there should be ample room for those who arrive on time.

Pray: Dear God, show us how to bring Jesus to others. Amen.


Think: How do you show that you believe God can do impossible things?

Just a reminder that our St. Vincent de Paul chapter here at St. Francis needs your help. They ask your help by using their poor boxes located in the church and


