DID YOU KNOW THAT THE CATHOLIC CHARITY APPEAL HELPS FUND THE DIOCESAN HEALTH CARE MINISTRY?

The program covers the costs associated with our diocesan priests visiting the sick in hospitals, nursing homes and private residences. The ministry coordinates priest coverage for 13 hospitals (2,500 beds) and the one RI in-patient hospice care facility. 75% of active priests, many who are retired from a parish, help to provide ministry and emergency coverage for our sick, elderly and dying brothers and sisters in these facilities. As Catholics, we know how comforting it is to have a priest with us in such difficult times. Because of your generosity, this program is funded every year, along with 30+ other ministries and services.



DID YOU KNOW THE CATHOLIC CHARITY APPEAL FUNDS ST. MARTIN DE PORRES SENIOR CENTER?

In addition to offering health screenings, the center coordinates with over 40 agencies to help seniors navigate the social service maze to locate resources such as Social Security, Medicaid, Food Stamps and more. Since COVID-19 began, the team visits seniors at their homes and brings meals to them. The Center is currently feeding about 250 people a week. Because of your generosity, this program is funded every year, along with 30+ other ministries and services.
