



From the Pastor,


Among the life-saving sources of income for our parish is the return we get from the diocesan Grateful for God's Providence campaign. As you may remember, and thanks to your generosity, we went \$200,000 over goal. We get 60% of that back and 40% of everything up to goal. God bless all of you who are able to keep up with your pledges and I would urge everyone to make sure that you are up to date with this commitment. Sooner or later, I shall be contacted by the people running the campaign to approach those who may have gotten behind in their payments—a task that I do not relish. So have pity on me and take preventive measures to forefend this.

I'd also like to repeat my thanks to all who helped to prepare for and execute the services of this year's Holy Week. It was great to be able to have them publicly again after last year's privation.

I'm looking forward at least to moving the tapes that block the pews to at least every other pew rather than every third. As soon as we get word that it is safe to do so, we'll do it. In the meantime, we have been urged by the medical community not to relax the protocols for keeping people safe from the virus.

Finally, please join me in praying that whoever the new pastor is going to be, he will be able to stir up our parishioners to resume the practice of the Faith.

We can accomplish more by working with other like-minded Christians. This ecumenical venture has been a most rewarding one as we were able to appreciate and respect our common convictions.

The PDDT is a joint venture of the Peace Dale Congregational Church and the St. Francis of Assisi Conference of SVDP. In twelve weeks, we have served almost 4,000 meals. Currently, over 50 St. Francis of Assisi parishioners volunteer to assist with the Friday meals by baking, cooking, serving, bagging, and delivering curb side or to residences.
