

## From the Pastor,


We are slowly returning to what we knew before the coming of the pandemic. I join with the Holy Father, our bishops, the medical community and the government in urging everyone who is eligible to get vaccinated. Let's do whatever we can to preserve the common weal and stop the spread of this virus.

You may have noticed that we have moved the tapes on the pews to make every other one, instead of every third one, available for seating. We are also resuming the passing of the collection baskets and the procession from the rear of the church to the altar. Please God, we shall be back entirely to the *status quo ante* in the next few months.

I cannot thank enough all the people who stepped up to ensure the smooth operating of the parish during this difficult time: the cadres of people who were willing to stand at the doors to welcome people, to see that they sanitized their hands and to find them seats; the teams who sanitized the church and chapel after every service, weekends and weekdays; the team who have stepped in at the chapel to try to cover all the things that Bill Harding used to take care of; the altar servers who have returned to assist the celebration of the Mass; Ryan Bernard who set up our livestreaming until we had the camera and the new system installed, and who continues to see to the scheduling of other liturgical services as needed. All these people made and are making it possible to carry on. I am paying homage here just to those who have helped with the extra labors caused by the pandemic; I haven't room in this space to thank all those who are serving and have served in other capacities to keep things running.

I must, however, give a special shout-out to our chief sexton, really our plant manager, Bobby Kelly. His workload expanded exponentially during this strange time and he remained as steadfast as ever in seeing to the smooth running of all the buildings and functions. From leaf-blowing to snow shoveling, to lawn mowing, to hedge trimming, the exterior of our properties is nearly a fulltime job. Who sets up for every event and cleans up afterwards? Who makes sure that light bulbs are changed, that bathrooms are cleaned, that door hinges are oiled, that boilers are serviced, that walls are painted, that walk ways are patched? And this is only the tip of the iceberg. Without the constant work of Bobby, I don't know what we would do. On behalf of the whole parish, I cannot thank him enough for his faithful service. May the Lord bless him with good health for many years to come!

#### ROSARY REPAIRS


