



# From the Pastor,

This weekend we remember especially those who gave their lives in service to our country, then all our relatives and friends who have gone before us. God rest their souls! We pray also that the scourge of war be removed from the earth with all the things that make war an option: all the injustice, the greed, the pride hidden in human hearts. Ultimately, the hope of Christians for eternal life is in the love of God shown us in the saving death and resurrection of Christ.

We also celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Blessed Trinity. Here is a brief reflection from Archbishop Augustine Di Noia. (CCC stands for the Catechism of the Catholic Church.)

#### The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity

Far from a merely academic concern of professional theologians, the Church's teaching about the Triune God "is the central mystery of Christian faith and life. It is the mystery of God in himself. It is therefore the source of all the other mysteries of faith, the light that enlightens them" (CCC 234). In contemplating and loving the blessed Trinity, we behold the truth of who God really is: a communion of Persons, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. It is that mystery and that life that we are called to share in: "The Church is a creation of the triune God: from the Father, who sends his Son and his Spirit to transform creaturely persons so that they come to share, with the uncreated Person of the Trinity and with one another, a communion of divine life: (Archbishop J. Augustine Di Noia).
