



I remember when I was in third grade, I was preparing to make my First Holy Communion at St. Bernard's in Wickford. We were having a rehearsal with Fr. Fred Halloran, the pastor. He gave me an unconsecrated host and I launched it into my mouth like a Dorito. His eyes wide, Fr. Halloran said, "Mr. Young...that's not how you receive Our Lord. You do it this way..." and he proceeded to show me the correct and reverent way to receive Holy Communion.

These weeks we have been hearing the "Bread of Life Discourse" of Jesus. He is reminding us that the Father will provide for us bread that will give us eternal life. It culminates at the Last Supper where Jesus says, "THIS is my body".

I often tell people that we don't come to Mass for the priest, or the music, or the homilies. Those are all hit or miss! We come to praise God and receive the Eucharist. St. John Vianney reminds us, "There is nothing so great as the Eucharist. If God had something more precious He would have given it to us!"
