





He had begun to give up his former life of partying and other vices which we shall not name on these pages! He visited a dilapidated chapel in the countryside that had obviously not been used in some time.

While he was inside saying a quick prayer, the crucifix spoke to him saying, "Francis. Go and repair my house which is in ruin". Young Francis took this to mean the small chapel so he renovated it to look like new. It became clear to him that the Lord had meant the Church Universal, and not the little chapel. It was at this moment he took his call to radical discipleship seriously.

Blessing of the animals will take place Sunday, October 3 around 12:15pm by the statue of St. Francis of Assisi on the side


