

Francis Church and the Chapel. Those members will be remembered at the at Masses during December. They will remain on the altar until the Feast of the Epiphany, January 2.




#### A NIGHT TO HONOR MARY Wednesday, December 15<sup>th</sup> at 6:30PM at St. Francis Church
