

Please call the rectory at least one year in advance to speak with Father Young. Due to the reduction in priests we can no longer accommodate Sunday weddings.



Dear Parishioners,

It was a cold and rainy morning January 6th, 1985. New parents were bringing their first born son to St. Bernard's parish in Wickford. He cried and wailed enough that no good pictures were taken. But from the moment the water poured over his head, he was a disciple of Christ.

That baby was your pastor (although I slightly embellished some details.) I was baptized on the feast of St. Andre Bessette. The long road to the priesthood began that day. Do you know the date of your own baptism? Do you still have your baptismal candle? I suggest in honor of The Baptism of the Lord this weekend, you do some investigating.

The rite of baptism is a beautiful and ancient prayer. In addition to the pouring of the water, there are prayers to the saints, anointings with oil for protection, and the "ephphetha prayer" in which the priest blesses the baby's senses to hear and see Christ. As we celebrate Our Lord's Baptism which began his public ministry, let's celebrate our own baptism which began our own!

And since it's the last day of Christmas today... Merry Christmas!

"TO THE PARENTS OF YOUNG CHILDREN:




plete you can be notified. Please drop your envelope off at the rectory or place it in the black mailbox next to the rectory door.


